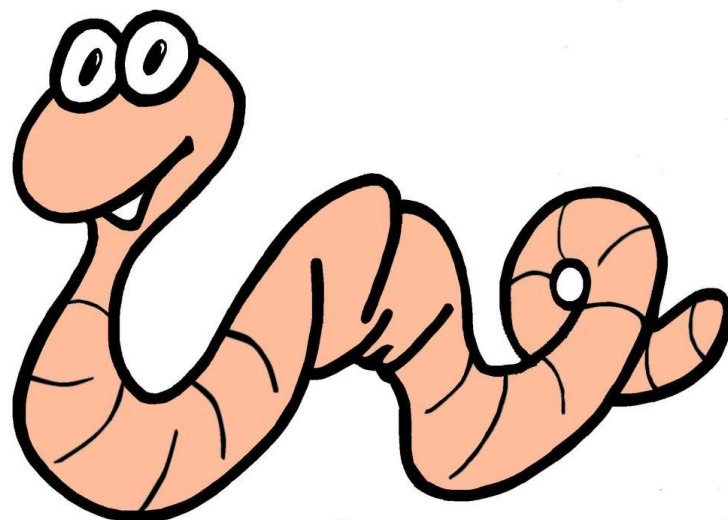


# Wanda 's Wonderful World.



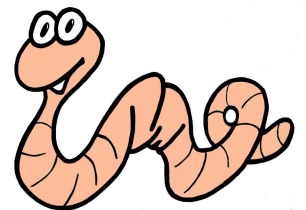
Wanda the wiggly worm wandered

Wanda wiggled over to a puddle to look at her reflection in the water.

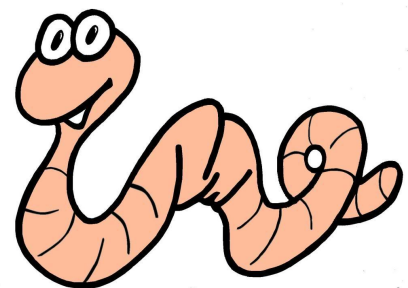
But to her surprise Wanda saw a circle of colours floating on top of the puddle.



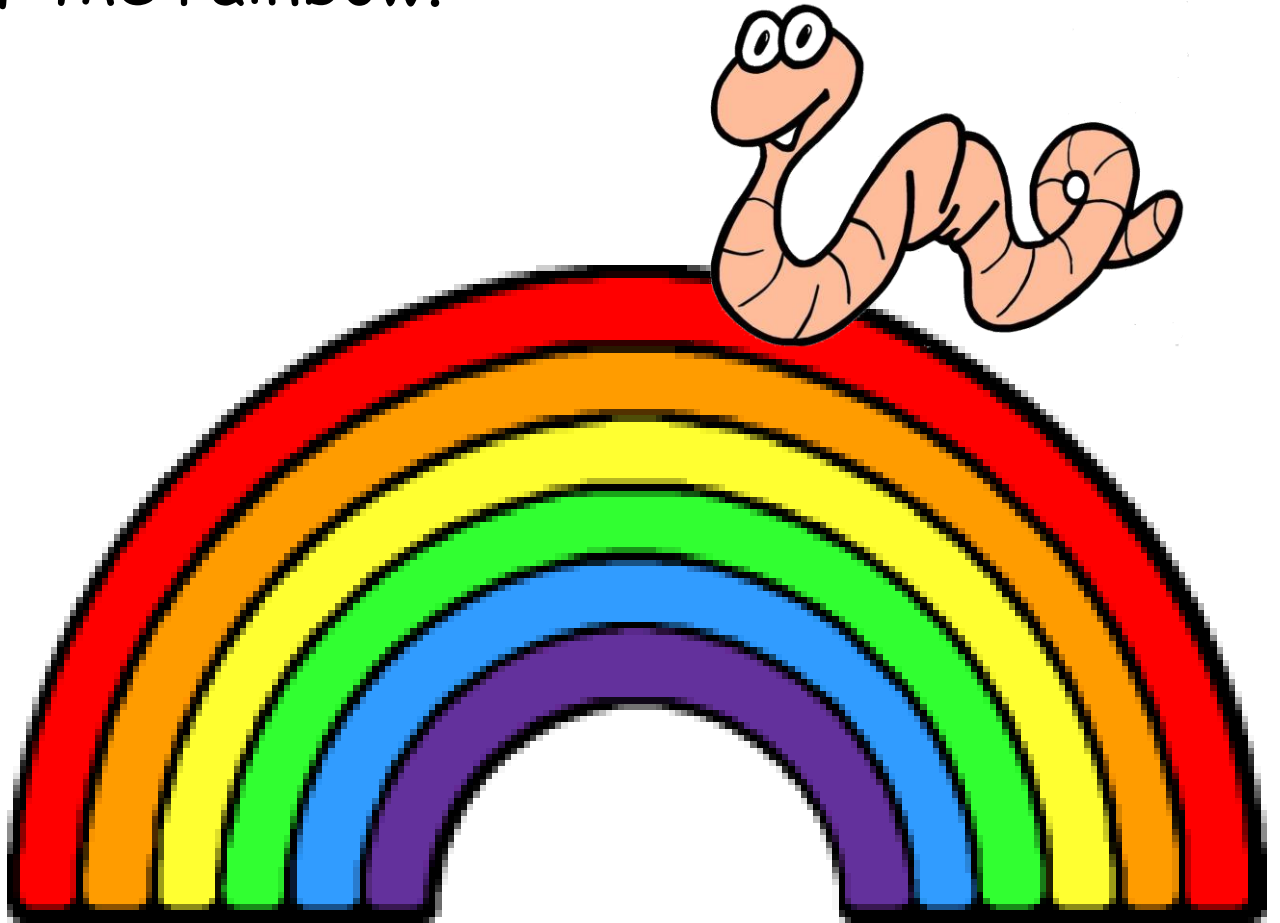
It looks just like the colours in bubbles thought Wanda.

(Use blow bubble solution and encourage children to watch as bubbles rise into the air)

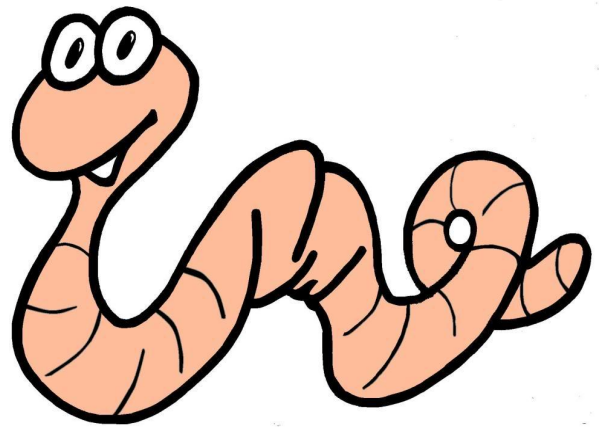
Why had that happened Wanda wondered? Perhaps it had been caused by an oil leak from Candy Carton's bright pink car.



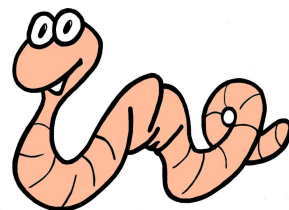
Wanda stopped and gazed at the colours. She could see all the colours of the rainbow.

(Big Mack...“Lift the lid and you will see lots of red inside of me”)

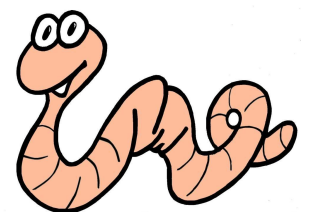


Orange .....Wanda thought about all the orange things she had seen.

Oranges, orange juice,

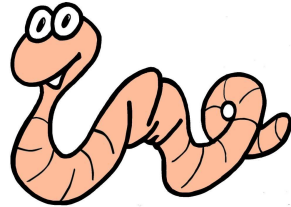


orange socks hanging on the washing line in Candy Carton's garden.

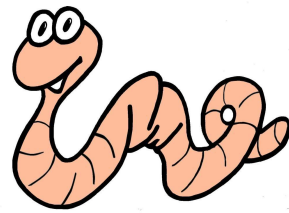




Yellow..... Wanda thought about all the yellow things she had seen.

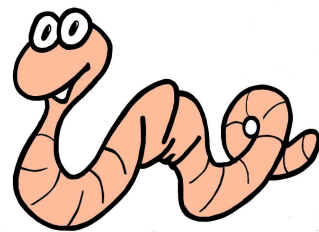


(Big Mack. "Lift the lid and you will see lots of yellow inside of me")



Green..... Wanda thought about all the green things she had seen.

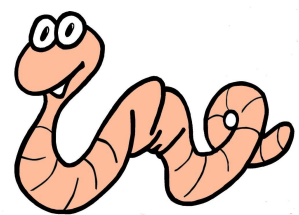
Green grass,



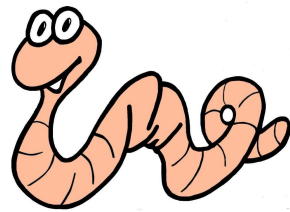
green trees



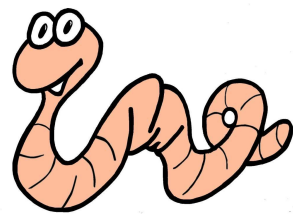
and her

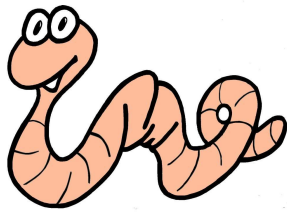
Blue..... Wanda thought about all the blue things she had seen.



(Big Mack) "Lift the lid and you will see lots of blue inside of me")

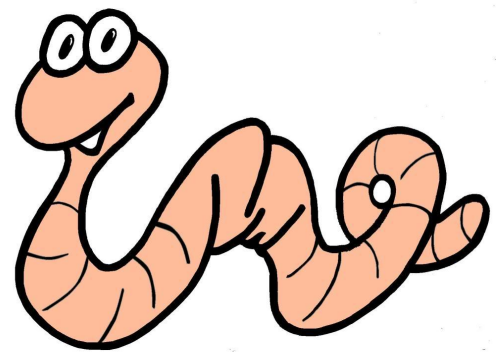


The blue merged into indigo and violet making a shade of purple.
